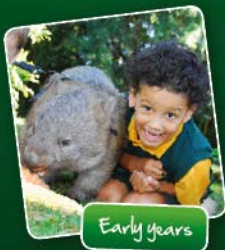

# Grade 3-5

There is also time for questions and answers at the conclusion of the Tribe Talk.
