

Terms and Conditions – Crikey! Magazine Photography Competition 2020:

1. Entries will be accepted from anywhere around the world; however, travel and prize redemption costs will not be covered by Australia Zoo.
2. Information on how to enter and the prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
3. Employees (and their immediate families) of the promoter, sponsor and agencies associated with this promotion are not eligible to enter. Immediate family includes any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, stepparent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, stepbrother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
4. Australia Zoo reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants and to disqualify an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
5. The promotion commences at 9:00am on 5 June 2020 and final entries close at 11:59pm on 31 August 2020 AEST. The judging panel will vote all winners of the 5 categories “Crikey! Magazine Cover, Crikey! Kids, Our Impact, Australia’s Conservation ‘Tails’ and Threatened Species” prior to 5:00pm 30 September 2020. Category winners will be notified before 1 October 2020 with the official announcement placed on Australia Zoo’s social media pages on 1 October 2020.
6. Finalists will be contacted on or before 10 September 2020 to supply an image subject (title), a description of the details the photographs backstory, location and any other noteworthy information (i.e. scientific merit) and if required, a full resolution image. This information must be provided prior to 17 September 2020.
7. To enter, the entrants must comply with all steps of the competition being:
 - a. Take your most creative wildlife photo that matches the theme of the category you are entering.
 - b. The photograph must be in portrait format for both Crikey! Magazine Cover & Crikey! Kids categories. For Crikey! Magazine Cover, consideration needs to be taken to allow for the 'Crikey!' mastheads which will be positioned over the top or bottom quarter of the winning photo.
 - c. All photographs must be provided in high resolution, JPG format and a minimum of 300 DPI. No borders, watermarks or signatures are allowed. Entries not meeting these requirements will not proceed to judging. For printing requirements, a full resolution of the image may be requested.
 - d. Each photograph must be labelled with your name, category, subject of the photo and if required, a number for multiple images of the same subject. For example, an acceptable file name is JaneSmith_CrikeyKids_Lion or JaneSmith_CrikeyKids_Lion2.
 - e. Enter via the links on the <https://www.australiazoo.com.au/photography-competition/> website page from June 5 2020 to August 31 2020 to be considered. Under 15 Years on 1 October 2020 for Crikey! Kids entry and 15 Years & over for all other categories.
 - f. A panel of judges consisting of expert photographers will choose the winners.
 - g. Wait until 1 October 2020 to find out if you are a winner!
8. Entrants 15 years of age & over may submit unlimited images once the entry fee has been paid. A single image may be entered in not more than two categories. Images are not accepted into the competition until the entry fee is paid. Entrants under 15 years of age on 1 October 2020 ('Crikey! Kids' entrants) are able to submit unlimited images and there is no entry fee for this category.

9. Before submitting your entries, please ensure your photographs are in technical compliance with the guidelines above. Entrants are encouraged to consider the ethos of the competition and to document the natural world in a way that is both creative and truthful. The objective is to remain faithful to original experience to not deceive the viewer or misrepresent the reality of the natural world. Localised adjustments should be used appropriately. Entries must be as digital files uploaded through the entry platform.

10. All entries must be the original work of the entrant, and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The entrant must hold the sole copyright in all photographs entered.

11. Photographs will be judged on overall impact, composition, originality and technical expertise. Judges shall be a panel of professional photographers who will judge images according to this criteria. All entries will be judged anonymously and all decisions will be final. The competition is based on photographs entered.

12. The prizes are non-transferable and not redeemable for cash. If any prize is or becomes unavailable, the Promoter, in its discretion, reserves the right to substitute all or any part thereof with a product or prize of similar value. All decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into. Australia Zoo accepts no responsibility for lost, late or misdirected entries. Entries will be deemed void if forged, inappropriate or offensive.

13. Entrants warrant that:

- a. Their entry is original and does not infringe on the intellectual property rights of any third party; and
- b. Their entry does not contain any content that is sexually explicit, violent or derogatory of any ethnic, race, gender, religious, professional or age group, profane or pornographic, is obscene or offensive or violates any law; and

2. the right to use your name, occupation, city, state and country of residence in any publication. We will endeavour to ensure that your images are always duly credited but do not take responsibility should your name be omitted.
