



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

CRIKEY! MAGAZINE PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION 2021

1. Entries will be accepted from anywhere around the world; however, travel and prize redemption costs will not be covered by Australia Zoo.
2. Information on how to enter and the prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
3. Employees (and their immediate families) of the promoter, sponsor and agencies associated with this promotion are not eligible to enter. Immediate family includes any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, stepparent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, stepbrother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
4. Australia Zoo reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants and to disqualify an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
5. The promotion commences at 9:00am on 5 June 2021 and final entries close at 11:59pm on 31 August 2021 AEST. The judging panel will vote all finalists and winners of the 3 categories "Crikey! Magazine Cover, Crikey! Kids and The Natural World" with the official winner's announcement made on the Australia Zoo's social media pages on 1 October 2021.
6. Shortlisted photographers will be contacted on or before 10 September 2021 to supply an image subject (title), a 75-word description of the details the photographs backstory, location and any other noteworthy information (i.e., scientific merit) and if required, a full resolution image. This information must be provided prior to 15 September 2021.
7. To enter, the entrants must comply with all steps of the competition being:
 - a. Take your most creative wildlife photo that matches the theme of the category you are entering.
 - b. The photograph must be in portrait format for the Crikey! Magazine Cover category. Consideration needs to be taken to allow for the 'Crikey!' mastheads which will be positioned over the top quarter of the winning photo. Entries will be accepted from anywhere around the world; however, travel and prize redemption costs will not be covered by Australia Zoo.
 - c. All photographs must be provided in high resolution, 3:2 aspect ratio, JPG format and a minimum of 300 DPI. No borders, watermarks or signatures are allowed. Entries not meeting these requirements will not proceed to judging.
 - d. Each photograph must be labelled with your name, category, subject of the photo and if required, a number for multiple images of the same subject. For example, an acceptable file name is JaneSmith_CrikeyKids_Lion or JaneSmith_CrikeyKids_Lion2.
 - e. Visit <https://www.australiazoo.com.au/photography-competition/> website page from June 5 2021 to August 31 2021 to be considered. Age qualifications are - Under 15 Years on 1 October 2021 for Crikey! Kids entry and 15 Years & over for all other categories.
 - f. A panel of judges consisting of expert photographers will choose the finalists and winners.
 - g. Wait until 1 October 2021 to find out if you are one of our winners!
8. Entrants 15 years of age & over may submit up to 100 images once the entry fee has been paid. Images are not accepted into the competition until the entry fee is paid. Entrants under 15 years of age on 1 October 2021 ('Crikey! Kids' entrants) are able to submit up to 100 images and there is no entry fee for this category.
9. Before submitting your entries, please ensure your photographs are in technical compliance with the guidelines above. Entrants are encouraged to consider the ethos of the competition and to document the natural world in a way that is both creative and truthful. The objective is to remain faithful to original experience to not deceive the viewer or misrepresent the reality of the natural world. Localised adjustments should be used appropriately. Entries must be as digital files uploaded through the entry platform.

10. All entries must be the original work of the entrant, and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The entrant must hold the sole copyright in all photographs entered.
11. Photographs will be judged on overall impact, composition, originality and technical expertise. Judges shall be a panel of professional photographers who will judge images according to these criteria. All entries will be judged anonymously and all decisions will be final. The competition is based on photographs entered.
12. The prizes are non-transferable and not redeemable for cash. If any prize is or becomes unavailable, the Promoter, in its discretion, reserves the right to substitute all or any part thereof with a product or prize of similar value. All decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into. Australia Zoo accepts no responsibility for lost, late or misdirected entries. Entries will be deemed void if forged, inappropriate or offensive.
